FBCGL Kids: In Egypt God saved his people twice. First, he passed over houses with the lamb's blood on their doorposts. Second, he opened and closed the Red Sea when they were leaving. God commanded his people to remember this rescue. Once a year the Israelites had a week-long feast called Passover to celebrate what God had done in saving them from slavery and death. But the command to remember wasn't the only good command God gave. In Exodus 20 God gave Israel the Ten Commandments. These ten rules show God's people what it means to serve and worship God. God didn't give the Ten Commandments and then save Israel. The order matters. First, he saved Israel, then he gave the Ten Commandments. The same pattern is true today. God doesn't tell us to be good so that he can save us. If he did, we'd all be in a real bad spot. Instead, he saves us first, as a gift, so that we serve Him only. "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt. . . . You shall have no other gods before me" (Ex. 20:2-3).
