**FBCGL Kids:** Job 1 - The Bible describes Job as "blameless and upright," as someone who "feared God and turned away from evil" (Job 1:1). He lived right in the sight of God and people. One day, some really bad things happened to this really good man. In one day, through one horrible incident after another, Job lost everything he owned and all ten of his children. Why did this happen? It happened because Satan told God that if Job lost everything, he would curse God. But God knew Job would keep trusting him, so he let Satan take it all away. And God was right. After Job lost everything, Job worshiped and said, "The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord" (Job 1:21). Job knew that God was still in charge and worthy to be worshiped.
